Flight times TBA You can exchange your money upon arrival to pay for your lodging at the Jetover Hotel in Savai'i and have some spending money you will need while in Samoa. Upon arrival in Apia check into The Insel Hotel for one night. We will be returning to this hotel after two nights in Savaii so you can pay for the 4 nights at this time so you won't be carrying your money around with you and risk losing it. **Remember at this hotel, we pay with US dollars! Double occupancy USD\$75 daily....Triple occupancy USD\$85 daily Samoa is one day ahead of American Samoa. We have crossed the International Date Line. When we get to Upolu, you will have time to wash clothes if necessary at the hotel. You will have time to take a cab to visit the marketplace (best place to buy souvenirs). Do not go alone, must go with a group or a buddy. Please inform Eva or Pele where you will be. Take time to rest as we have early departure in the morning. There is a little kitchen in your rooms; Great grocery store down the street to buy snacks, etc; the hotel restaurant is a good place to eat. The Pizza place down the road is a favorite also.
